**CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION**

**MU BETA ALUMNI CORPORATION OF KAPPA DELTA RHO**

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**UNDER SECTION 402 OF THE NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION LAW**

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**THE UNDERSIGNED, being a natural person of at least eighteen years of age and acting as the incorporator of the corporation being formed under the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law of New York, does hereby certify:**

**FIRST: The name of the corporation is Mu Beta Alumni Corporation of Kappa Delta Rho.**

**SECOND: That the corporation is a corporation as defined in subparagraph (a)(5) of Section 102 of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law.**

**THIRD: The type of corporation which the corporation shall be under Section 201 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law is type A.**

**FOURTH: The corporation is formed for the following purposes: (i) to organize and solicit voluntary contributions from the alumni of the Mu Beta chapter of Kappa Delta Rho and to expend such contributions for matters which are related to promoting the ideals of the Kappa Delta Rho Fraternity and to support the Mu Beta chapter of Kappa Delta Rho; (ii) to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, improve, construct, own, hold, use, maintain, operate, exchange, encumber, sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of, real or personal property of every kind, nature, or description as may be necessary or desirable to promote or support the Mu Beta chapter of Kappa Delta Rho; (iii) to promote, encourage and facilitate interaction between and among the alumni and undergraduate members of the Mu Beta chapter of Kappa Delta Rho; (iv) to make and perform contracts of every kind for any lawful purpose without limit as**

to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state, government, or municipal or political subdivision; and (v) to serve as an advisor to the Mu Beta chapter of Kappa Delta Rho. It is expressly provided that the foregoing enumerations of specific purposes shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation and that the corporation may do any and all other lawful acts or things and to exercise such powers, alone or in cooperation with other persons or organizations, incidental to or connected with the foregoing purposes which may be necessary, useful, suitable or proper for the advancement, furtherance, accomplishment or attainment thereof, but not for the pecuniary profit or financial gain of its members, directors or officers, except as permitted under the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law.

**FIFTH:** The office of the corporation is to be located in the County of Onondaga, State of New York.

**SIXTH:** The names and addresses of the persons constituting the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation are as follows:


**SEVENTH:** The duration of the corporation is to be perpetual.
